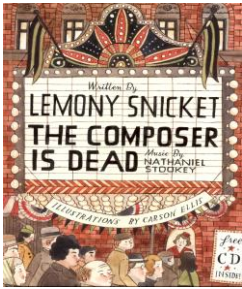

The Composer is dead and the Inspector must investigate all the instruments in the orchestra to find out who is responsible.

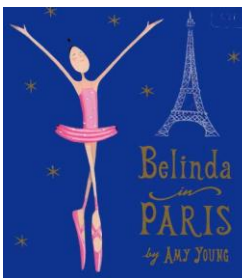


**Saturday, October 23, 2010**

When Pasha, a vain wolfhound, gets a role at the opera house, she loves the lime-light so much that she begins to sing on stage!

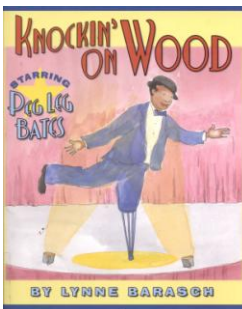


**Saturday, November 20, 2010**
