BOARD OF LIBRARY COMMISSIONERS TO MEET AT ROBERTSON BRANCH LIBRARY 1719 S. ROBERTSON BLVD., THURSDAY, FEB. 24, 11 A.M.

The Board of Library Commissioners, governing body of the Los Angeles Public Library, will hold its regular meeting on Thursday, February 24, at 11 a.m., at the Robertson Branch Library, 1719 S. Robertson Blvd.

Among the agenda items, the Board will consider City Councilmember Paul Koretz's proposal to change the Robertson Branch's public service days from the current schedule of Tuesday through Saturday to a new schedule of Tuesday through Friday, closed Saturday and open Sunday.

The meeting is open to the public and there will be an opportunity for individuals to address the Board of Library Commissioners.

The Los Angeles Public Library serves the largest population of any library in the country through its Central Library, 72 branch libraries, collection of over six million books and other items, and its Web site (www.lapl.org). These resources and its more than 18,000 public programs provide everyone with free and easy access to information and the opportunity for life-long learning.

The Robertson Branch Library is located in the Fifth Council District represented by Councilmember Paul H. Koretz.
