New Service Hours at Branch Libraries to Begin December 11, 2009

New service hours at the Los Angeles Public Library's 72 branch libraries will begin December 11, 2009.

The new service hours for the regional branch libraries will be: Monday – Thursday, 10 a.m. – 8 p.m.; Friday, 1:30 p.m. – 5:30 p.m.; Saturday 10 a.m. – 6 p.m.; and Sunday: 1 p.m. – 5 p.m.

Community branch libraries will be open Monday and Wednesday, 10 a.m. – 8 p.m.; Tuesday and Thursday, 12 noon – 8 p.m.; Friday, 1:30 p.m. – 5:30 p.m.; Saturday, 10 a.m. – 6 p.m. and closed on Sunday.

The Central Library hours will remain: Monday – Thursday, 10 a.m. – 8 p.m.; Friday 10:00 a.m. – 6:00 p.m.; Saturday 10 a.m. – 6 p.m.; and Sunday: 1 p.m. – 5 p.m.
