Robertson Branch To Change to Weekend Service Schedule Starting April 10, 2011

Starting April 10, 2011, the Los Angeles Public Library's Robertson Branch at 1719 S. Robertson Blvd. will change its weekend service hours and be open Sundays from 1 p.m. to 5 p.m. and closed Saturdays. The weekday schedule for the Robertson Branch will remain: Tuesday and Thursday, 12:30 p.m. – 8 p.m.; and Wednesday and Friday, 10 a.m. – 5:30 p.m. The Library's Web-based resources are available 24 hours a day at www.lapl.org.

The change was proposed by Councilmember Paul Koretz and made by the Board of Library Commissioners with community input. The new weekend service schedule provides the entire community with access to library service on Sundays, including the sizeable Orthodox Jewish community, which is unable to use the library on Saturday according to Jewish law.
