# HOW DO I FIND BiblioBoard?

In-Library and Home (Remote Access with a valid LAPL Library card) *BiblioBoard* is available online at all LAPL locations and remotely from the **eMedia** web page or within the **Research & Homework** alphabetical online resources list and under the subject categories of *General Information* and *Literature*.


### **DESCRIPTION:**

BiblioBoard features tens of thousands digital collections of eBooks, articles, images, photographs, maps, pamphlets, and documents as well as streaming audio and video content on a wide variety of topics from around the world. Curated collections, called anthologies, bundle the content on specific themes. An anthology is a collection of selected literary pieces or passages. Ebooks may be opened and read at the point of access or downloaded to be read later. All content is available on an unlimited multi-user basis with no checkouts or returns. You can access BiblioBoard content from the web or various mobile devices. Choose "Los Angeles Public Library" from the Library Credentials dropdown then enter your library card number and pin. Easy access to download the free apps is available on site. Launched March 2013, BiblioBoard works across most web and mobile platforms.

BiblioBoard will not be available on the public catalog computers.

### **HOW TO BEGIN:**

The first screen displays subject anthologies in 3 main divisions: *Featured*, *Categories*, and *Modules*. Use the arrows on either side of a section to move forward or backward to open one.



You can also click on Main Browse to view collections or Visual Browse to get a fuller glimpse of the contents of eBooks.

■ *Tabs in upper left hand corner*: [Click on the biblioboard icon to return to home page.]



**Browse All**: Click on to move forward in the Featured anthology covers.

**Favorites**: Entire anthologies or individual titles/images may be saved as favorites.

**Recents**: See recently viewed items and download PDF files for offline reading.

## **Special Features**

- 1) Advanced Search gives ability to refine search by Title, Publication Year, Publisher, Place of Publication, Institution, Language, Category, Content Format, License Type, Identifier.
- 2) *Special Options* will appear when you click on an eBook to enable manipulation and presentation of the contents. More titles and information in an anthology will display.



- 3) \_\_\_\_ click <u>left side for</u>: List view <u>right side for</u>: Image view
- 4) Audio sample search "Humpback Whale Song" Click on arrow to listen to sound.
