HOW DO I FIND ProQUEST platform?

In-Library and Home Access (LAPL Library card and PIN required for remote access)

PROQUEST online resources are available online at all Los Angeles Public Library (LAPL) locations and remotely from the LAPL website (www.lapl.org) within the Research & Homework page. LAPL list the most used databases in alphabetical order on the Research & Home page. These database are Los Angeles Sentinel Historical Archive, Los Angeles Times Historical Archive, San Francisco Historical Archive, Vogue Archive, PROQUEST Central, PROQUEST Newsstand and Research Library (PROQUEST).

DESCRIPTION

The *PROQUEST* platform is made up of multiple online indices and archives. It contains over 17,000 magazine and journal titles and covers over 160 subject areas such as business, health, world affairs, science and literature. **Note:** *PROQUEST* Research Library and *PROQUEST* Newsstand are listed as part of the *PROQUEST* Central database.

HOW TO BEGIN

Select a *ProQuest* database from the Research and Homework list.

To search, **enter** keywords in the "basic search field." The "basic search field" searches all indexed fields including any available abstracts and full-text documents.



To **read** an article, abstract or view a full citation record, **click** on the article title, "Abstract/Details" or the "Full text" link.

Articles can be printed, emailed and saved in a variety of formats by using the links Email Print More on the article list or article page. Additional save and print options are available by **clicking** on the "More" link.

SPECIAL FEATURES


PROQUEST users can:

• Create a citation in APA, MLA, Chicago, Turabian, etc. by using the \$9 cite link. The citation can be cut and pasted onto a bibliography or reference list.

• Create an optional "My Research" account to save articles, searches, set preferences and much more. To create an account **click** the **1** icon on the upper

right-hand corner of the page. From the menu that opens, select Sign into My Research. The sign in/registration page will display.






• Switch between *PROQUEST* databases or search multiple *PROQUEST* databases simultaneously by **clicking** on the "Change databases" link on the top toolbar.
