## HOW DO I FIND *LearningExpress Library*?

In-Library and Home (Remote Access with a valid LAPL Library card)

*LearningExpress Library* is available online at all LAPL locations and remotely from the Home Page under **Research & Homework** alphabetical online resources list and under the subject categories of *Education, Jobs & Careers Gateway, Online Learning, and Student Sources, Teen Web* under *Homework Help*, and on the **Adult Literacy** page under *Learn Online*.



**DESCRIPTION:** *LearningExpress Library* provides free online interactive practice tests, including college preparation (SAT, ACT AP, PSAT/NMSQT), career building tools, skills remediation (math, reading, writing), grad school tests, vocational tests, and citizenship prep. Learn how to improve individual skills and sharpen your test-taking skills. Immediate scoring, complete answer explanations, and an individualized analysis of your results are all part of the program. Run your cursor over each of the revolving centers to get an idea of their content. The centers cover: Adult Learning, Career, High Equivalency, College Prep, Recursos Para Hispanohablantes, College, and School. When selecting a test, click on the name of the test to display a detailed description, number of questions and estimated time. Tests can be repeated.

**HOW TO BEGIN:** There are many opportunities to see videos on how to use the website, beginning with the very prominent **user guides** on the home page and shown below. It is worth viewing as a content and searching aid. **User guides Topics:** *Full Length Video, Registering as a New User, Logging in, About Centers, Searching, How to Take a Tutorial, How to Take a Test, How to Download and Use an eBook, My Center, and Contact Us*. Click on a topic listed in the left bar to go directly to that information in the video.



When you see this symbol, select another topic,



and click on the arrow again.



▼ Above each page, the navigation bar gives you access to *All Centers* and *User Guides*.



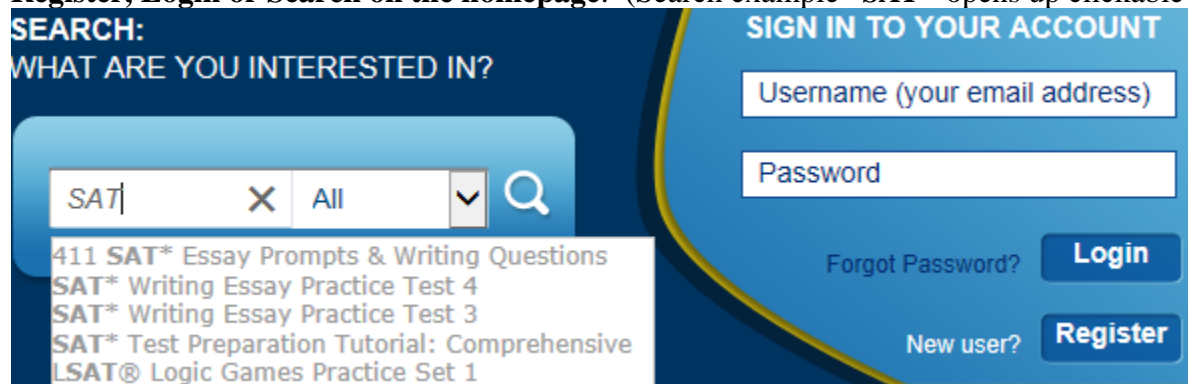
*Help* also contains User Guides, Contact Us, Registration, System Requirements and FAQ.

Select any one of the centers in *All Centers* (takes you to the same place as the revolving centers on the home page). This bar appears with additional content information for that subject under *Guidance* and *Resources*.

### **Special Features**

**My Center** – shows products and tests completed or in progress and any recommendations based on tests for user. Will appear on navigation bar when you are registered.

**Tests can be taken as many times as you wish.**

**Save and Finish Later** tab - click to save in your *My Center* to be continued later.



**View Score Report** tab can be viewed where you stop or when test is completed.

**Test Preparation Tutorials** – will review by concepts and types. For pre-tests, to begin click “Start Course” now, to diagnose strengths and weaknesses and target your review. If you know your focus you can skip and go to any unit lesson topic by clicking on the name in the expandable menu on the left side of the page.
