To run the Print Client on a Mac environment (Intel-only), click the link <u>here</u>.

Note: To close the Mac Print Client, select "Quit LPT One Mobile Print Client" from the LPT One Mobile Print Client menu.




-Enter an e-mail address, either put in an URL or browse your file. **Don't have an e-mail? Just simply make up one. (It does not need to be a valid e-mail account)**





Your job is ready when it shows "Your request has been processed."




Now you can enter your e-mail address at the Print Release Station to print your document.


The Print Release Terminal looks just like before:




Please input the password or e-mail address (for Mobile printing) in either places:

You will be sent a release code for the email message and each attachment. Use these release codes to retrieve your documents. Email forwarding is ideal for online email portals such as Yahoo!, Hotmail or Google Mail.

Why?

Most online email services require that you log-in to access email. If you provide the URL (web address) of your message, the printing services will be blocked because your email login name and password are not known by the print system.
