(Los Angeles – August 1, 2013) Complete digital copies of your favorite magazines are now available to download for free from the Los Angeles Public Library website, www.lapl.org. The service is provided by Zinio, the world's largest online magazine subscription service.

Using your Los Angeles Public Library card and smartphone, tablet or personal computer, you can gain access to more than 230 publications, including *ESPN*, *Us Weekly*, *Newsweek*, *Rolling Stone*, *Runner's World*, *Martha Stewart Living*, *Mac World*, *PC* and many more.

The service is available 24 hours a day, seven days a week and, unlike print-format magazines, digital magazines don't need to be returned to the library and are never overdue.

Zinio is the latest in a growing number of free Web-based resources offered by the Los Angeles Public Library, which include electronic books, films, language learning and continuing education courses as well as downloadable music.
