SUBJECT: ACCEPTANCE OF GIFT BY EPSON AMERICA

## **RECOMMENDATION:**

That the Board of Library Commissioners adopt the following resolution:

RESOLVED, That a gift to Digitization & Special Collections of the Los Angeles Public Library of three (3) scanners with a market price of \$4,747.00 by Epson America, be accepted, and;

FURTHER RESOLVED, That a letter of thanks be sent to Epson America for their generous donation.

## FINDINGS:

- 1. On the occasion of longtime Los Angeles Public Library Map Librarian Glen Creason's retirement, an article appeared in the Los Angeles Times celebrating his career with the Library.
- 2. The Manager for Research & Special Collections received an email from representative Jeannie Gustlin on behalf of Walt & Company Communications which stated that they had read the article and that their client, Epson America, expressed interest in making a donation of scanners for preservation of maps in honor of Mr. Creason's retirement.
- 3. Walt & Company Communications representatives consulted with Digitization & Special Collections staff regarding their scanner needs, and thereafter donated and shipped, free of charge, three Epson scanners on behalf of their client, Epson America: the Epson DS-32000 large format scanner, the Epson DS-1630 flatbed color document scanner, and the Epson DS-780N color document scanner. The market price of these scanners is \$4,747,00.
- 4. These donations to the Los Angeles Public Library's Digitization & Special Collections Department increase our capacity to scan more of our collections for preservation and access, and are sincerely appreciated.
