SUBJECT: ADOPTION OF FISCAL YEAR 2020-21 BUDGET

#### RECOMMENDATIONS

That the Board of Library Commissioners:

- 1. Adopt the Library Department's operating budget for Fiscal Year (FY) 2020-21 in the amount of \$205,334,363, as approved by the Mayor; and
- 2. Approve the transfer of funds in the amount of \$2 million within the Special Account 9510 from LAPD Security Services to a newly created line item to be titled as "Reimagining Safety Initiative" within the Library's FY 2020-21 budget, Fund 300, Department 44; and
- 3. Per direction from the Board of Library Commissioners at the June 25, 2020 meeting staff will develop a plan: a) to use the \$2 million for the Reimagining Safety Initiative to identify alternate approaches to supporting safe and welcoming library environments that do not rely on law enforcement, and b) to appropriate any unused portion of the \$2 million to the Library Materials budget; and
- 4. Appropriate \$278,817 of non-designated funds in the Library budget to the Contractual Services Account 3040, Fund 300, Department 44, for Central Library Alterations and Improvements; and
- 5. Appropriate \$75,001 of non-designated funds in the Various Special Account 9510 to the Contractual Services Account 3040, Fund 300, Department 44, for Central Library Alterations and Improvements; and
- 6. Adopt the attached Resolution regarding the Library Department's FY 2020-21 Budget in the amount of \$205,334,363, as approved by the Mayor.

#### **FINDINGS**

#### LAPL Budget

- 1. The total operating Library Department Budget for FY 2020-21, as approved by the Mayor, is \$205,334,363. The Library's Charter-mandated appropriation increased by \$13,403,277 in FY 2020-21 from the previous fiscal year.
- 2. The proposed Library Budget for FY 2020-21, as submitted to the City Council, is comprised of \$205,334,363 in revenue and \$205,055,546 in expenditures, resulting in \$278,817 of undesignated funds. The Library requests that this unappropriated amount be appropriated to Contractual Services Account 3040 for Central Library Alterations and Improvements.
- 3. The proposed Library Budget for FY 2020-21, as submitted to the City Council, is comprised of a total of \$79,799,897 in appropriations and \$79,724,896 in expenditures in the Various Special Account 9510 for related costs, resulting in \$75,001 of undesignated funds. The Library requests that this unappropriated amount be appropriated to the Contractual Services Account 3040 for Central Library Alterations and Improvements.
- 4. The budget for Library Materials has increased by \$1 million from \$16,242,375 to \$17,242,375. Thus, the materials expenditures per capita will increase from \$3.36 in FY 2019-20 to \$3.61 in FY 2020-21.
- 5. The attached Adjustments to Related Costs table itemizes the direct and indirect costs, which comprise the Library's related costs. The total related costs for FY 2020-21 is \$79,724,896 and represents 38.86% of the total Library budget.
- 6. The adopted budget includes funds for critical initiatives, increased print and electronic materials, robust and innovative technology, and increased opportunities for civic engagement. The adopted budget will also advance the Library's key priorities, including:
  - Support the Library Strategic Plan's six goals, including outreach and promotion to enhance public awareness of the Library's services and programs.
  - b. Strengthen and enhance the Library's information technology (IT) infrastructure, and provide new IT equipment for the benefit of Library patrons.

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- c. Add funds for alterations and improvements at branch library locations, including replacement of air conditioning units to provide more dependable cooling for the public during periods of extreme heat.
- d. Continue the implementation of the Library's public relations and marketing plan.
- 7. The adopted budget includes an additional six (6) positions to enhance operational and administrative support for international and digital collections, engagement and learning, security and emergency preparedness, contract administration and purchasing, and warehouse operations.

#### Reimagining Safety Initiative

8. A team led by Kren Malone, Director of Central Library Services, will develop a plan for the Reimagining Safety Initiative (RSI). This team will identify alternate approaches to supporting safe and welcoming library environments that do not rely on law enforcement. They are conducting research and developing a plan that includes training for staff, mental health and public health support and resources, cultivation of community partners, community outreach, facility improvements, and other areas. In addition, the team is discussing what the outcomes of the project should be and how to evaluate the success of the RSI. The Library will report to the Board about the plan and the proposed use of the \$2 million.

FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Board of Library Commissioners hereby approves the transfer of funds in the amount of \$2 million within the Various Special Account 9510 from LAPD Security Services to a newly created line item to be titled as "Reimagining Safety Initiative" within the Library's Fiscal Year 2020-21 Budget Fund 300, Department 44.
