


Contamination

is sediment or organic material suspended in water resulting in visibly dirty water.



Contamination

are substances that are present where they shouldn't be, or are at higher concentrations than they would naturally have occurred.



Contamination

are bacteria, viruses, and parasites that are responsible for waterborne diseases, such as typhoid fever, cholera, dysentery, polio, hepatitis, and schistosomiasis.
