ProQuest Historical Newspapers: Los Angeles Sentinel (1934-2005)

HOW DO I FIND *Los Angeles Sentinel*?

In-Library and Home (Remote Access with a valid LAPL Library card)

Los Angeles Sentinel is available online at all LAPL locations and remotely from the LAPL website within the **Research & Homework** alphabetical online resources list under the title *Los Angeles Sentinel Historical Archive* and also listed in the subject category of *Newspapers*.

DESCRIPTION: Community and world issues from the unique cultural perspective of the Los Angeles African-American community. Coverage from 1934 to 2005.



View more than 70 historical years of cover-to-cover reporting through the eyes of African-Americans with first-hand accounts and coverage of the politics, society and events of the time, from the Depression in the 1930's and the progression of the civil rights movement and social change issues in the community and world, to 2005.

- Browse complete issues, cover to cover.
- Search by more than 20 article types, keyword, date ranges, specific dates, author, and more.
- View news articles, photos, advertisements, classified ads, obituaries, cartoons, and more.
- Print and download articles and images in PDF format.
- Translates into more than 15 languages.
- Set up *My Research* through *Preferences* to save searches and set personal settings.

HOW TO BEGIN: Put a search term in the box, select *Basic Search*, *Advanced*, or *Obituaries* and their limiters and click on the Q (question mark). *Publications* option is not applicable here.

The search **Results** page will provide a “*Sort results by:*” section on the right side with helpful dropdown options: *Relevance*, *Publication date* (oldest first) or (most recent first), *Document Type*, *Publication date 1938 – 2005* (decades), or a specific date range to sort or narrow results.

Special Features

- 1) [Preferences](#) | [English](#) ▼ | [Help](#) ? -located in the top right hand corner of the page.

Sign in and set any personal Preferences (language, interface setting and display, results display, citations, export). The language can be changed quickly by clicking the English dropdown to the right of Preferences.

- 2) [Modify search](#) | [Tips](#) -both links are located beneath Basic Search box on the right hand side.

- 3) [Preview](#) -hold cursor over *Preview* icon to review abstract (summary) contents and indexed publication details of full record. Contains action icons to *Save to My Research*, *Email*, *Print*, *Cite* and *Export/Save* (also found on the bar at the top of the Results page).

- 4) ☐ 1 -check box to **Mark Items** to distribute to one of the icons listed in number 1 above.

- 5) To view full page, click on article title. Click on **Page view**

You can use Ctrl + or Ctrl – to zoom in or out of the page for better viewing. Select article by putting cursor on an article or item to have it enlarged. Icon panel will appear on bottom right.



The left 4 icons allow you to enlarge or zoom in on the article. The 5th icon allows “save as” & 6th print.

- 6 **Hit-term highlighting** identifies search terms more easily throughout the context of the article.

- 7) **Create alert & Create RSS feed** links do not apply to a historical archive that will not be receiving new documents.

- 8) **Save search** – click on to create a *My Research* account or sign-in your *My Research* account.
