PARKING INFORMATION

You will need a LAPL library card to validate parking. The parking garage is located on **524 SOUTH FLOWER STREET**. Parking will be on a first come, first serve basis. Parking validation is available at the Library Information Desk (1st floor). Patrons can obtain validation upon presenting a LAPL library card

Non-Validated Parking: We highly suggest that you validate parking since non-validated parking is \$3.50 per 10 minutes and can accrue up to \$35.00 daily maximum.

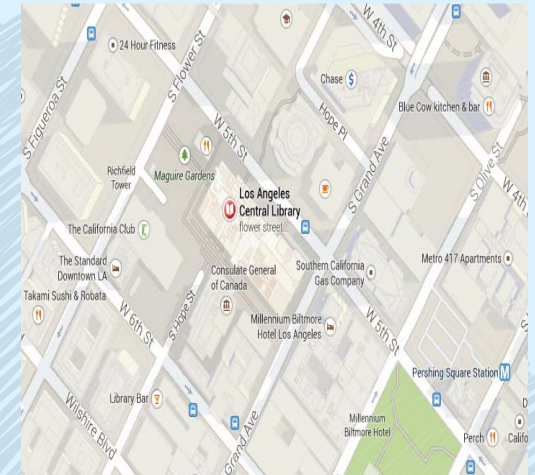
PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION

We recommend that you use public transportation since library parking will be limited.

Riding the Metro Bus (16/17/53/55/62/460/720) and (14/70/71/76/78/96/487/707/770) is only a short walk to and from the library.

Riding the Dash Bus (721/701) is also a short walk to and from the library.

- * For the (16/17/53/55/62/460/720) line, exit on 5th & Grand (NW Corner)
- * For the (14/70/71/76/78/96/487/707/770) line, exit on Grand & 5th
- * For the Dash line (721/701), also exit on 5th and Grand
