User Guide

To access the apps available on your iPad, go to the App Catalog icon.

Select the apps and download to add them to the device.

Library-recommended apps may be downloaded at users' discretion without an Apple ID.

Note: iPad must be connected to the internet for downloads.

Overdue/Lost Fees

Returning Your iPad

- Loan Period: 3 weeks
- Fully charge the iPad until the battery is at 100%.
- Item must be returned to the library from which it was originally borrowed.
- Return the device, along with all contents, to a service desk or staff member.
- ***DO NOT return iPad in the Book Drop.***
